# College Annual Report 2020-21

In the academic year 2020-21 of Swami Ramanand Teerth College, the total number of degree students in the arts faculty of the senior college was 394. Total number of students in Commerce Branch was 250. The number of Commerce students for post-graduation in the year 2020-21 was 113. The total number of undergraduate and postgraduate students from both arts and commerce faculty, in the year 2020-21 was 941. Among the results, the result of BA third year in 2020-21 was 83.52% percent. The result of B. Com. third year in 2020-21 was 87.87% percent. The result of post graduation in the year 2019-20 was- M. A. Hindi 88.88%%, History 78.57%%, Political Science 73.07%, Sociology 87.50%%, Economics 69.23% and M.Com.74.41%. In the academic year 2021, Chiranjeev Sheikh Shahrukh, a student of the Department of Sociology, has passed the SET examination and Mrs. Sadhana Haridas Madke has passed both the SET and NET examinations in the subject of Sociology.

#### **IQAC Annual Report-2020-21**

#### **Annual Planning**

The annual educational planning for the academic year 2020-21 and other activities and programs were planned at the beginning of the academic year i.e. June 2020 on behalf of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) with a five year plan. In the COVID-19 Pandemic situation there was completely locked down from March 2020 to October-November 2020. The remaining Term End Examinations of March-April for the academic year 2019-20 were conducted in October 2020. Therefore, the session which was to begin in June 2020, actually it was started in November 2020. Of course the annual plan prepared in June 2020 was updated in November 2020.

Department-wise planning was prepared by various departments as per the college plan. The Micro Teaching Plan of various subjects and courses was meticulously planned and activities were also planned. The portfolio distribution was made up of various work responsibilities and committees in the college. From December 2020 onwards, according to all these plans, teaching activities and various activities started to be implemented.

#### **Meetings of the IQAC**

During the year 05 meetings of IQAC were held to plan the for the overall development of the college, to plan its successful implementation and to evaluate the activities undertaken. The Governing Council is the highest regulatory and managing body in terms of the Organogram of the College and at the college level the 'College Development Committee' (CDC) is the actual executive management. IQAC meetings have been held before, presumably in view of CDC meetings. It is therefore convenient to seek CDC approval as required by the decision of the IQAC meeting. This year's IQAC meeting will review the five-year planning plan, prepare the annual plan, approve the planning plan and budget of the department and various committees, determine the action plan for the implementation of various initiatives, review the program, Appreciate the good work of teachers and staff, suggest improvements where necessary. The decision was taken after discussing the issues of observation, finalization and submission of AQAR of the college. Action was taken accordingly.

#### Slow and Advanced Learners Identification

Concept level test was conducted for the identification of Slow and Advanced Learners in the year 2020-21 and identified Slow and Advanced Learners. Different activities were conducted for the both the groups by the concerned departments.

#### **Admission campaign**

Admission campaign was launched at the beginning of the academic year after all sorts of planning and calendars were created. IQAC planned to visit several nearby junior colleges. The students who passed Class 12 were contacted and given guidance regarding the courses, facilities and career

development available in the college. Forming four to five teams of college professors, almost each team visited five to six junior colleges, a total of 25 junior colleges. Students and parents were enlightened. For this, he got the cooperation of the principal and staff of the junior college. The admission process was completed in November 2020. The actual teaching started from December 2020.

#### Various workshops & orientation programs Attended by Faculty Members

12 faculty members out of 22 attended various FDPs, Refresher programs, Orientation Programs, Workshops and Short Term Courses. Total 23 programs were attended by the faculty members in the Academic Year 2020-21.

#### Various workshops & Orientation Programs Organized

Due to the lockdown, teaching and activities were conducted online. From January to February 2021, the lockdown was partially reduced. The actual teaching started in February 2021 but started to lock down again and this condition remained till the end of July 2021, so online teaching, component tests and all the programs had to be taken online. University examinations held in August 2021 were also conducted online. Since online teaching learning is to be followed, various workshops & orientation programs were organized on various meeting applications e.g. Google Meet, Zoom App. and Microsoft

Teams App etc. For this, on 5.12.2020 and 3.3.2021, guidance was given to the entire staff on the use of Google Meet App, Google Classroom and Google Forms in teaching and evaluation.









Online Orientation Program and Principal's Address for the newly enrolled students were organized on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2020 and information was given about the courses available in the college, certificate courses, Add on Courses, Gandhi Study Center, Library, Department of Drama, Gym and Indoor Stadium, Hostel Facility, Network Resource Center and other available facilities. College rules, discipline and the role of students were explained. Information was given about various activities organized in the college throughout the year. Various workshops and parallel sessions were also conducted for the students who were lagging behind in their studies. Various competitions, presentation programs, seminars, educational trips and visits, internship programs, workshops on syllabus related concepts and related to soft skills etc. were organized for the students. For this, the Department of Political Science, English, Commerce, Economics, Public Administration, Defense Science, Drama took initiative. IQAC monitored all of these events.

#### Mentorship program

Mentorship program was implemented to provide personal guidance to the students who are lagging behind in studies and need help, to solve their problems and bring them into the mainstream of education. The Mentorship Program is implemented to address students' learning difficulties as well as to help them with their personal questions, problems, help, guidance and direct assistance where necessary.

All students entering college undergraduate and postgraduate classes are divided into available and working teachers. Teachers are given guardianship of these students. Teachers try to solve their problems by staying in touch with the students throughout the year. Individual visits and group meetings of students with whom you have a responsibility are conducted by all teachers at their respective levels. Meetings and visits help students to understand and understand their difficulties. All the teachers have created whats app group of their Mentee students and they are in touch with the respective teachers through this group. Twice a year, at the college level, the principal, vice-principal and IQAC coordinator all meet together at Mentee. Mentor teachers do not attend this meeting. So do Mentee students get help and guidance from Mentor teachers? Are their problems solved? This is reviewed. Student difficulties and problems are learned. The difficulties and problems of the student are taken into consideration. Attempts are also made to address these issues at the principal and deputy principal levels. In some cases, action is taken by giving instructions to the teachers concerned. A meeting is also organized with the representatives of the institution by inviting all the Mentee students. Therefore, this initiative benefits from the guidance and monitoring of GC and CDC representatives. It also evaluates the activities implemented throughout the year.



#### Academic, Administrative, Gender & Green Audit:

Whether all the teachers' teaching and evaluation work and discharge of their responsibilities as teachers are being carried out properly? Are there any gaps in it? With keeping all these factors in mind, guidance & assistance had have been provided to teachers where necessary. To make available the proper guidance and to give enough support and assistance to the teachers, Academic Audit is conducted every year with the purpose of enhancing its quality. An internal audit is done by forming a committee at the college level. It is analyzed and given the opportunity to improve by giving the necessary instructions to the teachers concerned. An external audit committee is then convened at regular intervals to conduct an academic audit of all the teachers. Teacher-wise assessment reports prepared through external audits.

Teachers are honored for their good performance in academic audit. The academic audit report is analyzed to find out the best performing teachers. Internal audit of the year 2020-21 was done during 25th July to 30th July 2021. In which the performance of 4 teachers remained excellent and they were honored in Staff Academy. Out of the total 22 faculty members 6 were intimated to improve their teaching in terms of completion of the syllabus in time and properly. These Teachers informed in writing that they need to improve their work and document maintenance also.

Various environmental awareness programs and tree planting, anti-pollution campaigns were implemented throughout the year. Also, special efforts were made to create gender equality in all. On the occasion of Mahila Atmabhan Shibir, Savitribai Phule's Birth Aanniversary, Balika Utsav and Lokshahi Jagar were organized from 22nd January to 30th January, through which efforts were made to create gender equality and environmental awareness. Green Audit and Gender Audit were conducted at the end of the year.

#### **Bridge Course, Certificate Courses and Value added courses**

Various Certificate Courses and Value Added Courses are run in the college under the supervision and guidance of IQAC. This year, due to the pandemic and lockdown of COVID-19, these various courses had to be taken online. The first semester of this year started in November-December 2020 due to the lockdown. Therefore, various courses are generally conducted between December 2020 to February / March 2021 and further in May-June 2021. The results of the courses completed in March 2021 were announced in April-May and the results of the courses completed in June were announced in July-August 2021. Certificate distribution program was organized on 30th October 2021 and certificates were distributed to the students who successfully completed the Certificate Courses and Value Added Courses. Secretary of Yogeshwari Shikshan Sanstha Shri Ganpat Vyas and Treasurer Prof. Manikrao Lomte were present on this occasion.

Bridge Courses were organized by various departments. This activity also had to be organized online. The curriculum was chosen based on the concepts that the students found difficult or completely new to them.
