How the governance of the institution is reflective of and in tune with the Vision and Mission of the institution?

Swami Ramananda Teerth College is run by Shree Yogeshwari Educatin Society which was established in the pre-independence period. In addition to providing national education, the pre-independence goal was to create the necessary environment for the freedom struggle, it also aims to inculcate a sense of nationalism in the younger generation and in the society, inculcate patriotism and self-sacrifice, and bring people from all walks of life, mainly the underprivileged, into the stream of education. In the post-independence period, most of the initial goals and policies were carried forward by making some necessary changes, with the aim of building a capable youth to build the country in the post-independence period and implement a proper education plan to meet the national objectives of the nation. Since higher education facilities were not available in all rural areas at that time, the aim was to provide higher education opportunities to rural students in Marathwada. Not only that, but there is also an emphasis on imparting life skills and education required for self-employment. In order to inculcate the value of democracy in the next generation, decentralization of power and inclusion of all in the decision making process has been taken up by the institute. All of these policies and objectives are still reflected in the management and operation of the college and institution today. Shree Yogeshwari Educatin Society has been considered as an institute of teachers and staff since its inception. Teachers and staff members have the right to send their representative by election in the executive board of the Society (Institution) and on the local governing body that is CDC of the college also. Staff members are involved in strategic decision making of the institution and the college. Institute always adheres with the principle of decentralization and participative management. The approach of the administration for formulating and implementing the policies is totally democratic and inclusive. This approach gives operational and academic freedom to the College Development Committee, Principal, Co-ordination Committee and to staff members, to evolve and implement appropriate mechanisms and procedures.

We have been working with our Vision and Mission, which reflect the objectives and principles of the Constitution. We have been undertaking the task of building the capable citizens needed to strengthen Indian Democracy. Our pioneer gave us such footprints by the Vison and Mission. Due to this we have been intentionally working In order to achieve the principles of democracy and our national objectives and to create awareness about the constitution as well as to inculcate the principles of the constitution among the students. Some programs are organized purposely as mentioned below. Jagar Lokshahicha Aplya sarvancha, Gandhi Saptah, Savitri Utsav, Swami Ramanand Teerth Vyakhyanmala, Kurundkar Vyakhyan Mala, Late B K Sabnis National Level Elocutin Competition, Sanvindhan Jagruti Karyshala, Matdar Jagruti Karyshala, Gender Equality Awareness Programme, Programme for inculcating National Integration, Various Street Plays based on different values, Various Workshops, Play performances etc. In order to overcome the educational difficulties of the 'Down Trodden Students' and to provide them with better educational opportunities, the institution decided to build new Boys and Girls Hostel buildings, To develop sportsmanship among the students it was decided to develop a Big Playground and Indoor Stadium, To inculcate the Science Temper among the students, institution decided to develop a 'Science Center' with all facilities, To preserve the legacy of our freedom struggle and the memory of those who gave us freedom, institute has been decided to setup Big Memorial Hall i.e. "A Museum of Hyderabad Freedom Struggle and Rev. Swami Ramanand Teerth"

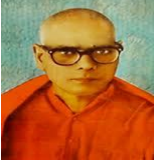
The institute runs Mahatma Phule Hostel constructed on the donation from well-wishers, alumni and other stakeholders. It is run on no profit basis since almost the inception of the college. The economic source of this hostel is management of Shri Yogeshwari Education Society and staff members of the college. Mahatma Phule Hostel is a unique community service helping the marginalized students. The intension of this facility is not only providing students the lodging and boarding but also making them self-dependent through various activities such as cultivating vegetables in the hostel premises, preparing compost and organic fertilizers, motivating them to be self-dependent by doing part time work such as catering, Newspaper distribution and part time jobs at different firms. Faculty members take extra efforts to make them ready for the jobs by inculcating Communication, Marketing, Accounting and leadership skills.

Students are given the responsibility and authority to carry out various activities by giving them the participation through various committees. Such programs are monitored only at the college level. Students are represented on the IQAC and CDC committees of the college and efforts are made to develop their representation and leadership skills. Students are given an opportunity to study the problems of the society by organizing various programs at the social level and taking them to the community through outreach programmes. At the same time, teachers and teaching staff are involved in the decision making process through decentralized management. Principal as the head of the institution works on the principles of decentralized and participative execution of the administration by giving the responsibility to each one from the institution which leads to collective leadership and democratic approach to administration. Some time they are given the power to make their own decisions for the department activities. Departments are given autonomy in department wise activities and programs.

Parents and alumni gatherings are also held to participate and support them in the management of the college and in various programs. The goals and objectives of the college are to be achieved through such management and take initiative to create good citizens, inculcate various life skills among the students and build in them the ability to carry out various responsibilities.


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Information about the Governance is reflective and in tune with the Vision and Mission

From the very beginning, our Yogeshwari Education Society has been making planned efforts to achieve the goals and objectives. Five to Ten year planning Action Plan or IDP is prepared and various projects are undertaken accordingly. As the institution is committed to the national goals and values of the constitution, the backwardness of Marathwada and the difficulties faced by the majority of the people in this region in joining the main stream of education, the institution has to keep in the forefront of its objectives.

Therefore, various activities and programs are undertaken to inculcate the values of the constitution in the coming generations and to achieve the national educational goals. E.g. In the freedom movement of the country and especially the people of this part i.e. Hyderabad state, Our Pioneer, Governing Council Members and teachers took the initiative to get freedom from the oppressive Nizam rule. Our Yogeshwawri Education Society led this freedom movement. Similarly, this provided the young revolutionaries needed for this movement. Many students of this institute and college were directly participating and leading in this movement.

This institution, college, professors have contributed significantly in establishing the Marathwada Janata Vikas Parishad, which is working for the development of this area and further through this organization(MJVP), to guide the development issue of this area and to create awareness in that context. The institution itself organizes various programs of superstition eradication and to inculcate the Scientific Principles, to inculcate scientific attitude in the students and society, sometimes supporting and co-operating with the Anti-superstition Movement. At the same time, the institution has undertaken the important task of providing opportunities for science education and development of experimental skills not only to the students of this college but also to the students of many schools and colleges in the area by building a grand and well-equipped Science Center.

As a part of addressing the educational difficulties of rural students, the institution had set up separate hostels for boys and girls in the 1960s. As it fell into disrepair, the institution decided in its planning to build a separate hostel for male and female students again in these ten years. Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Hostel and Yogeshwari Girls Hostel have been built with the contribution of University Grants Commission, public participation and especially alumni and entrepreneurs, philanthropists of the society. In the same way, the organization has planned and completed the task of building a grand indoor facility with the contribution of alumni, well-wishers and philanthropists of the society.

An annual action plan & Budget is prepared taking in to consideration of IDP (Institutional Development Plan). Matters to be completed in that year are given priority as per the urgency and availability of resources also. The funds available are also considered in determining the annual work plan and budget. Programs are undertaken accordingly. The policy of the college is to raise funds for the completion of long-term projects from stake holders and from revenue also. At the same time, the wellwishers of the institute and the

charitable congregations in the society who love the YES institute & College are appealed. Alumni come forward as a priority and provide financial assistance as per the call of the institute and the college. Therefore, according to IDP, it is possible for the college and Yogeshwari Education Society to undertake various projects. The following are some projects undertaken and completed successfully as the Institutional Development Plan (IDP).

1) Indoor Stadium (2018-19 & 2019-20)

As per the XI Plan of UGC, Indoor Stadium with an estimated budget of Rs. 9600000 / - was sanctioned to the college. For this, Rs.6900000 / - was sanctioned share from UGC but actually Rs.3250000 / - was received by the college from the University Grants Commission. The University Grants Commission (UGC) had extended the deadline to March 2019 due to rising costs and fundraising. Estimated Budget increased up to 13200000/-Rs in between the extended period. In such a situation, the 3250000 / - received from UGC was falling short. The college would have to spend immediately as the remaining subsidy would be deducted after completion of construction.

The college and Yogeshwari Education Society have decided to raise funds by appealing to the stakeholders as the increased Estimated Budget and the share of the total expenses incurred by the college will be borne by the college. The construction of Indoor Stadium of 13200000/-Rs was successfully completed. The Indoor Stadium has 3 Badminton Courts with synthetic flooring and 1 Court with wooden flooring. Parking and security guards facility including VIP Gallery, Table Tennis Hall, Physical Directors Office, Visiting Room for Parents, Changing Rooms & Waiting Rooms for Boys and Changing Rooms & Waiting Rooms for Girls, adequate WC, Bath and Utility facilities were made available. This successfully constructed Indoor Stadium was inaugurated on 13-5-2019 in the presence of National Player and former student of the organization Akshay Raut, his father Mr. Prabhakar Raut and Badminton Punch Mr. Burande. Dr. Suresh Khursale, President of the Society and other GC Members, CDC Members and office bearers were present on the occasion. In the academic year 2019-20 and 2020-21, the indoor stadium is in full swing and Mr. Sachin Pahade, a badminton coach, is currently mentoring here. College students and players from nearby colleges/Schools are taking advantage of this. The college is earning good income every year by deducting the maintenance, salary and minor expenses of the indoor stadium from the admission fee of the student for indoor.

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2) Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Boy's Hostel (2020-21)

The hostel has been running in the college since its inception. Swami Ramananda Tirtha College is located at Ambajogai in the center place of Marathwada. Rev. Swami Ramanand Teertha and his colleagues started the college at that time to provide higher education to the rural students in the backward areas like Marathwada. At that time, higher education was available only in places like Hyderabad, Mumbai, and Madras. In 1950, Dr. Ambedkar started Milind College at Aurangabad and Rev. Swami Ramananda Teertha started People's College at Nanded. After that Swamiji started senior college of Yogeshwari Education Society in 1956 in rural areas like Ambajogai. From that, in 1970, two colleges were started by separating science and arts and commerce branches. Mahatma Phule Hostel was set up in 1967 to accommodate students from rural areas. The organization also set up other hostels, especially for girls. However, since Mahatma Phule Hostel provides accommodation and meals to the students at very low and affordable cost from the very beginning, students from the deprived, Dalit, backward and economically weaker sections come here for education. Many poor students learned and grew up by living in this hostel. Not only in the state of Maharashtra, but also all over the country and abroad, the students of this hostel are making a name for themselves and the college by working in various capacities in various fields. The college and Yogeshwari Education Society decided to construct a new building in 2018-19 as the building of this hostel was constructed in 1967 is coming to be demolished. The project of the construction of this new building for this hostel was also incorporated in the five year Institutional Development Plan (IDP) of the college. Our institute completed the construction of the hostel by raising funds for the priority project. Many alumni, directors of the institute, office bearers, teachers of the college and staff members also have taken the initiative and contributed financially and a building of about 4 crore Rupees has been successfully completed. Due to the COVID 19 pandemic some difficulties and barriers interrupted the construction work but the GC Members, Chairman of Y.E.S. and the college

completed the construction with utmost perseverance. This hostel is an excellent example of a project that is included in the Institutional Development Plan and successfully completed. Today, the dormitory is completed with a magnificent three-story building of **84** rooms with a capacity of about **250** students. The construction of the hostel has been completed in the year **2020-21** and the hostel has been inaugurated in November **2021** by famous thinker Dr. Hari Narke and Prof. Dr. Raosaheb Kasbe from Maharashtra. At present this hostel is providing excellent accommodation and meals to many needy students from rural areas at very reasonable/ affordable rates.

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3.) Construction of Science Center: (2021-22)

The institute decided to set up a well-equipped and grand science center to develop scientific attitude in the students and to develop the skills of doing science experiments in them. The construction of this science center was taken up four years ago. The construction is nearing completion in the present year 2021-22 and will soon be operational. Realizing the lack of well-equipped laboratories in nearby school and colleges in rural areas, the institute decided to set up this center keeping such students in front. The following various facilities and rooms have been set up, are being set up in this Science Centre.

1. A planetarium has been set up where the sky viewing will be done from a scientific perspective so that the students can understand various celestial phenomena, solar and lunar planets.
2. A science museum with various instruments and toys based on the fundamentals of science
3. A library is being developed which includes scientific reference books, scientific magazines, biographies of scientists e.
4. A 3D auditorium where students can have a wonderful experience through 3D movies.
5. Laboratories for various subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Mathematics are being developed.
6. A science park is being set up so that students can understand the basic principles of science through various games and enjoy the game.

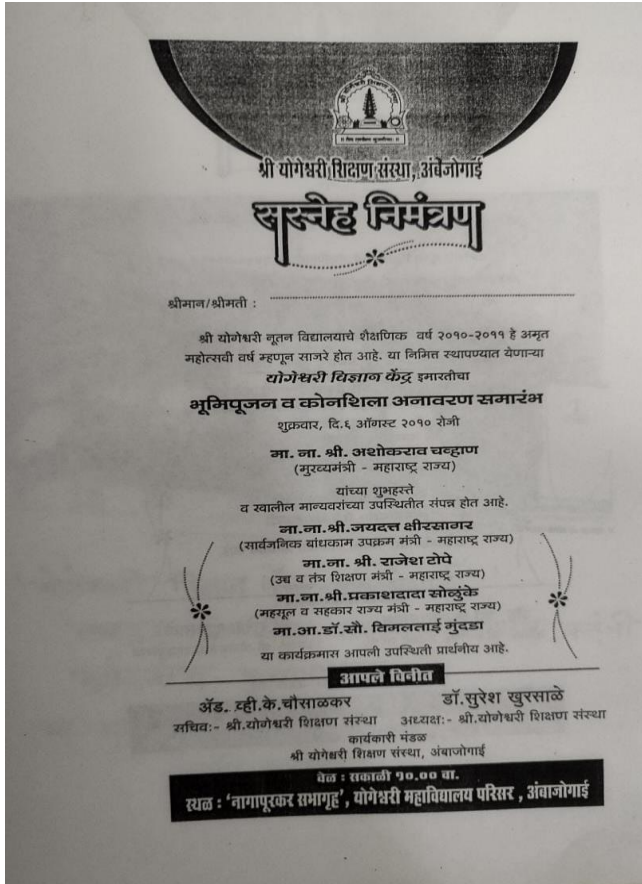
The foundation stone laying ceremony of the present science center was completed by the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra Hon'ble Namdar Shri Ashok Chavan in 2010-11. The government had agreed to provide funds at that time, but the government did not receive funds for this science centre. The institute has set up the present center by collecting funds from the society and alumni. So it took some delay. The project which was supposed to be built in five years took more than ten years. But the college and the institute have always resolved to raise funds for it keeping their IDP in front and we are happy that finally the science center is now nearing completion.

Information about the Governance is reflective and in tune with the Vision and Mission

Our institution gives priority to democratic principles and works with the important goal of promoting democratic and constitutional values and inculcating them in the next generation. From the very beginning, we have cultivated the importance of everyone's participation and respect for everyone's opinion. Teachers and staff are represented on the governing council of the institution as well as on the local development committee of the school college. Not only this, his opinion is honored by giving representation to faculty, staff and students in the college development committee and various constitutional review committees of the college. Brief information regarding the composition and functioning of all these committees is as follows.

Governing Council (GC) Teachers and professors were at the forefront in founding the Yogeshwari Education Society and the College also. Swami Ramanand Teertha and Babasaheb Paranjape the promoters of the institute actually both were teachers. The Principal of the college, Shri A. M. Kulkarni, later became the president of the institute. Even today, teacher staff representatives are elected in the GC of the Yogeshwari Education Society. Teachers, professors and staff members are intrusted in important decisions of Yogeshwari Education Society and the college. They are involved in the decision making process. The GC is currently represented by two teacher's representative and the principal. Professors are elected, while principals are ex-officio members.

College Development Committee (CDC) The CDC of the college i.e. College Development Committee is constituted as per the rules and regulations of the Maharashtra University Act of 1994 and Maharashtra University Act 2016. The CDC is responsible to the Governing Council of Yogeshwari Education Society. Teachers and professors are adequately represented in the College Development Committee. According to the University Act, two teacher representatives, one female teacher representative and one non-teaching staff representative are elected through the election process. Similarly, a representative of the department head and two experts from the social sector and two education experts are selected by the principal under the guidance of GC.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) IQAC has been constituted as per the guidelines of UGC and NAAC and has been functioning in the college since .2004-2003The principal of the college is the chairman of this committee and the chairman of the institute also supervises the committee as a senior guide and advisor. Representatives of other organizations are also elected in this committee. There are also representations from social workers, educationists and teachers and staff. The main thing is that college students are also represented in this committee.

Coordination Committee: At the beginning of the academic year, Principal formulated the Coordination Committee for the effective functioning of the administration and academics in the Institutions. The chairman of the Coordination Committee is Principal of the college. Vice principal of the college is the member secretary of this committee. P. G. Director and Four representatives from heads of the departments, Librarian, Office Superintendent and Students' representatives are the members of the Coordination Committee. Every policy matter, requirements of the departments and Academic planning and execution, the proposals and decisions are forwarded by 'Staff Academy' are discussed in the coordination committee and placing it in the College Development Committee.

Staff Academy: Staff Academy of the college is the integral part of decentralized and participative management. All the staff members are represented through the staff academy in the various strategic decisions of the college and in the implementation of various initiatives. Their views are determined in strategic decisions. The staff academy as well as the coordinating committee and then the administrative officer, the principal and then the College Development Committee and the Governing Council of the organization is already in a hierarchical structure. Most of the decisions are taken in the staff academy by consulting the staff members. The policy matters, academic calendar, schedule of the different programmes, time table, staff and students grievances are discussed and finalized in staff academy and communicated to coordination committee and CDC for approval and execution. All teaching and non-teaching staff is the members of staff academy. There is a staff secretary who coordinates the staff academy with coordination committee and with all office bearers with principal. Staff secretary has taken initiative in the activities of Staff Academy. Felicitation programme, Best wishes programmes, sendoff and welcome ceremony also had have been taken by the Staff Academy. Research Paper Presentation Programme and Book Reviews also been taken.
